### Common Core Literacy Scaffolding Questions

Teachers who choose to use these questions in a state that has not adopted Common Core standards are encouraged to apply their own state standards to these questions. Teachers, please note that these questions are designed only to provide a very basic literacy scaffold and to provide examples. There is plenty of room for you to add your creativity and use your expertise to develop "why" questions and to help students make connections to other texts.

The questions below should be answered using a complete sentence and with textual evidence from the reading. The questions for the Preface are answered as examples.

### Introduction

 When he was growing up in a poor Panamanian fishing village, what did Mariano Rivera think he would do when he grew up? Sample Answer: Mariano Rivera "thought that he would follow his father into the fishing industry."  Give one example of something that Mariano Rivera has done since his retirement from Major League Baseball.
 Sample Answer: Since he retired, "Mariano devoted himself to philanthropy and his churches."

- 1. Give one detail about the country of Panama.
- 2. What happened to Mariano Rivera that made him stop going to dance clubs at night?

- 3. How much money was Mariano Rivera offered to sign a contract with the Yankees?

- 3. Give an example of how Mariano Rivera's family life changed after 1991.

- 3. Give an example of how Mariano Rivera played in the 1995 series against the Chicago White Sox.




